Cheryl Parrott is the Manager of City of Perth Library. Her appointment to the role in September 2011 coincided with the appointment of the architect and building concept for the new City of Perth Library. Over the course of the next four years she actively contributed to the development of the library building whilst preparing the library team for the new library. In early 2016, the much anticipated seven level City of Perth Library opened to the public - then the real fun began.



Paula Pfoeffler worked as Coordinator Library Services at Bayside Council and was responsible for delivering the new Rockdale Library, which opened in July 2016. She has over 20 years working in public and school libraries in Australia, England and Bolivia. She is now the Community Learning and Library Services Lead at Campbelltown City Council where she is working with a project team to deliver a new Civic Library for the City. Opening Rockdale Library was a career highlight as it demonstrated how well-designed spaces can change public perception of what a library is and create new community connections.
